1	Pigs, Stingrays/Sharks and Tour of Green	Visit the swimming pigs on No Name Cay. Enjoy	9:30am – 4:00pm
	Turtle Cay	feeding them and taking photos. Then travel north and feed the stingrays and sharks on Man Jack Cay. At the end of all that excitement, visit, tour and have lunch on historic Green Turtle Cay.	
2	Deep Sea Fishing	Spend a day on a beautiful blue ocean trolling for the "big one."	4 OR 6 hours

5	Snorkelling, Bottom Fishing and Picnic	Begin with some amazing snorkeling before jumping in the boat and catching your own fish and having it cooked for you on a private beach along with Bahamian side dishes. Minimum 5 people 9:00am – 4:00pm	9:00am – 4:00pm
